What you'll do:

Site and Guest Experience

- Keep the campsite looking beautiful and welcoming, safe and secure - checking fire pits, maintaining clear walkways, and following health and safety processes to keep guests and staff protected.
- Maintain a friendly, approachable presence and be prepared to answer guests' queries or find someone who can.
- Muck in with the kitchen team if required.

Maintenance & Operations

- You'll be entrusted with keeping the campsite running smoothly, spotting what needs doing and making sure every guest's experience is great, without waiting for instructions.
- Keep facilities (showers, toilets, communal spaces) clean and well-maintained.
- Clean, check and maintain pre-pitched tents, ensuring each guest arrives to a perfect setup.
- Report repair and maintenance issues if anything requires attention.

Sustainability & Environmental Stewardship.

- Lead by example in Woodfire's sustainability efforts in managing waste, recycling, and composting processes.
- Ensure campsite systems support our low-impact ethos, reducing waste and improving efficiency.

- Has great friendliness and communication skills; ideally with some experience in hospitality.
- Has a passion for the outdoors and sustainable living and doesn't mind a bit of rain or sunshine.
- Takes ownership of their role, is hard-working and takes a pride in maintaining high standards and an understanding that every guest's experience matters.
- Has a can-do attitude. We are a small, family-run business and sometimes it's all hands on deck!
